

Graduation Requirements

At Roxboro Community School, all students participate in the college-preparatory course of study and will graduate with the prerequisites required for admission into a university in the UNC system.

4 units – English (I, II, III, IV)

4 units - Mathematics (Math I, Math II, Math III, and one higher course)

3 units - Science (Biology, Chemistry, and Environmental or Earth Science)

4 units - History (World History, Civics and Economics, and American History I and II)

2 units - Foreign Language (including one course beyond the first year)

1 unit - Healthful Living

4 units – Electives

22 Units Total

In addition, students must score at Achievement Level III (with one standard error measurement) or above on the end-of-course assessment for English I, Algebra I, and Biology and successfully complete a Graduation Portfolio that is monitored and scored within the School.
