# Roxboro Community School



The Roxboro Community School AP Academy is designed to further the RCS mission to achieve and maintain educational excellence by providing a small, inviting and nurturing school that focuses on grades six through 12.

The AP Academy is open to rising 9th grade students who are current RCS students, including new students accepted through the Open Enrollment Process.

The AP Academy combines rigorous AP courses, foreign language instruction, opportunities to study abroad, and community service to provide a high school experience second to none.

## Goals of the AP Academy:

- To provide students with opportunities to achieve success in a culture of academic excellence and rigor.
- To graduate students competitive for admission and scholarships at top universities.
- To provide the opportunity for college credits earned in high school through Advanced Placement classes.
- To graduate students bilingual in a foreign language through coursework and opportunities to study abroad.
- To provide opportunities for personal growth through service learning.
- To offer support through teachers specially trained by the College Board.
- To meet all North Carolina and RCS graduation requirements.
- To meet the requirements set by the RCS AP Academy.
  - A minimum of 8 AP classes during students' four years
  - Maintain a cumulative un-weighted GPA of at least 3.5
  - Minimum 40 hours of cohort-selected community service
